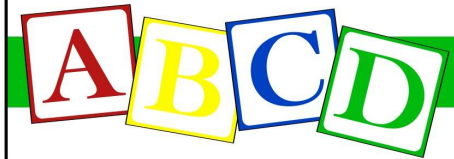

Our Program

Mt. Hebron Nursery School is a private, non-sectarian, non-profit school for two, three, four, and five year old children. We offer a variety of class options for your child based on their age.

Both our AM, PM, and extended day programs offer theme based developmentally appropriate programs designed to nurture and educate the children in all areas of development.

Educational activities for both academic skills and social and emotional development are introduced at circle time and embedded throughout the day as children learn by doing.

Children interact in large group, small group and individual class activities through out the day with a strong emphasis on language development, literacy, and math. Specialists in music, physical education, and art provide additional interactive programming for our students.

Enrichment Program:

Mount Hebron Nursery School Enrichment Program is designed to provide additional learning opportunities for students atier their regular school day. The students will engage in unique, challenging and fun activities exploring a variety of topics and themes. These enrichment classes will offer students opportunities to explore particular interests and extend their learning experiences. The Enrichment Program is a multi-aged seti ng for children who are three, four or five years old. The Enrichment Program is offered from 1:00-3:00 PM.

Discovery Clubs:

Discovery Clubs offer an opportunity for children to explore and discover a variety of topics. Small group, hands-on, child-centered activities peak and satisfy their natural desire to learn. Clubs are offered in three, eight week sessions through out the year atier the regular school day.

The School Year

Our school year is from September through late May. We attempt to align with Howard County Public School System's calendar for holidays and closings.

Philosophy and Goals

Mt. Hebron Nursery School is concerned with the development of the total child. Attention is given to the intellectual, social, emotional, physical and creative growth of each child.

Our Goals Are To Help Children:

- Develop an interest in words and reading
- Expand their communication skills
- Develop an awareness of the world around them through their five senses
- Develop an understanding and acceptance of themselves, with the result being a healthy and positive self-image
- Develop an understanding and acceptance of others, including their family and friends
- Learn to share with others
- Develop the ability to express their emotions in constructive ways
- Develop creativity in a variety of mediums
- Care for their physical well being with health and safety concerns
- Learn to embrace their own and other's cultural differences

Daily Classroom Activities

- A warm and welcoming greeting followed by:
- Fine Motor
Playing with puzzles, cooking experiences, art activities, water/sand table ,manipulative toys
- Gross Motor
Playing with large blocks, climbing, painting, housekeeping, dramatic play
- Group Times
-Singing, sharing, finger plays, stories
-Themes set for the day and skill introduction
- Snack Time & Outdoor Play (weather permi ti ng)
- Specials
Includes physical education, music, art, enrichment program, area performers and field trips.



MHNS and State Requirements

★ All children should be toilet trained before atiendaing Mt. Hebron Nursery School (MHNS); With the exception of students in the 2 day 2 year old class.

★ As required by the Maryland State Health Department, all medical forms need to be in the school office no later than the first day of school.

Enrollment Procedures

The waiting list for the following year starts forming on **October 1st. Please visit our web site and register online: www.mthebronnursery.org**

- * Children whose parents are members of Mt. Hebron Presbyterian Church will be given first priority on the waiting list. They will also be eligible for a 10% discount (if contributing members of the church).
- * In January, students currently enrolled and their younger siblings, are given first selection for enrollment on a first-come first-served basis.
- * Registration is offered to those on our waiting list in January to fill the openings in our two, three and four year old programs.
- * A child is registered when 1) they are contacted by the school; 2) their registration form is completed (first time enrollment only); and 3) the annual \$155 per child non-refundable registration fee is paid and for new students the fist months tuition is paid.

Each classroom will have a credentialed and degreed Lead Teacher and Assistant Teacher.

Registration Age Requirements

2 day 2 year old	Child is age 2 by September 1 of program the year he/she will attend
2 day 3 year old	Child is age 3 by December 31 of program the year he/she will attend
3 day 3 year old	Child is age 4 by April 1 of the program year he/she will attend
3 day, 4 day, & 5 day 4 year old	Child is age 4 by December 1 of the program year he/she will attend
